About the Event

Why, You Ask?

Corporal Christopher M. Shea of the Delaware State Police was a native of Hampton, NJ and a 1990 graduate of Kittatinny Regional High School. Chris was an avid runner and a member of the Cross Country team as a student athlete. At first, Chris chose college as the path to achieve his career goal of becoming a state police officer. Due to the financial pressure of attending college, he later decided to serve in the U.S. Marines after he discovered this as an alternative to reaching his goal. Chris was always proud of his service.

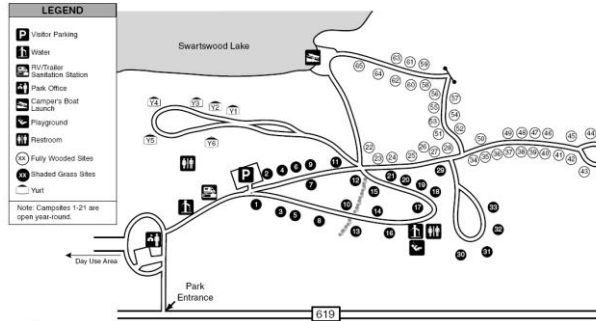
Chris accomplished his lifelong goal in 2000 when he was chosen by the Delaware State Police. He spent the next 4 years protecting and serving his community while doing a job he loved. Chris was tragically killed on July 18, 2004 when his cruiser was struck head on by a vehicle being operated by a drunk driver.

The annual **Corporal Christopher M. Shea Memorial 5k** is a yearly event that was started in 2005 to raise money for high school graduates and college students entering the fields of Law, Law Enforcement, and/or other Civil Service. All profit from the money raised is awarded as scholarships to graduating seniors of Kittatinny Regional High School and current criminal justice students at Sussex County Community College in honor of Christopher M. Shea.

To date, the event has awarded over \$15,000 in scholarships to qualifying and deserving students.

The 5k Course

The course is a double loop of the rustic Swartswood State Park camp grounds. The run will start and finish on the shores of Swartswood Lake.



The Battle of the Badges

The **Battle of the Badges** is a unique race challenge that allows dedicated servicemen and women to demonstrate their commitment to their jobs and their community. The Battle of the Badges challenges the various civil service agencies to rally as many of their strongest, fastest, most committed and, most importantly, most competitive members to help remember a brother, serve a community and show everyone just how great they really are.

Agencies register as a team and compete against other agencies during the race. Each teams' results are scored using standard scoring methods for running events (top 5 finishers from each team) and the agency who achieves the best overall performance at the race will have their name engraved on the coveted **Battle of the Badges** plaque to be displayed at its headquarters until the following year, when the Battle continues.
